Students enjoy sharing their work with an audience outside the classroom, and for many students this opportunity is a powerful motivator. The staff in our district welcomes the chance to share what's happening in Hockinson classrooms with the community.

Our student teachers sometimes make videotapes of themselves leading teaching lessons so they can receive feedback from their professors and fellow student teachers.

Teachers may use web pages to share student work and post pictures of students engaged in classroom activities.

Occasionally, the District Newsletter publishes stories about classroom activities as well as individual student achievements which may include photographs of the students involved.

We believe these kinds of activities contribute to our school and to student learning.
