Cost:

Half Day (5 hours or less) \$25 p/day

Full Day (over 5 hours up to 10 hours) \$45 p/day

Weekly Full Day \$200 p/week

Requirement:

Must be a student of HSD in grades K-5. Children attending must be fully toilet trained, able to self-feed and behave in such a way that they do not pose harm to self or others.

To register, simply fill out the registration forms. Online forms available at hocksd.org under community education. Paper forms may be turned into the district office. Register early! Camps have limited spots.



Guidelines:

- We will be following the guidance from the Washington State Health Department.
- Your child's temperature will be taken prior to entry.
- If your child or any family members have been sick please stay home for the well being of others.
- No adults will be allowed to enter the Hockinson Community Center.
- Frequent hand washing will be required.
- All children must bring and wear a mask during camp.
- Drinking fountains will not be accessible.
- Please send a water bottle and snack/lunch with your child daily.
- In order to prevent the spread of germs, we will provide art supplies to be used at camp by your student only.
- No toys or other items from home will be allowed.

HERE'S WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

DROP-OFF

A staff member will meet you and your child outside of the Hockinson Community Center to check them in. No adults will be allowed into the building. Your child's temperature will be taken prior to entry. If it is 100.4 or above your child will not be allowed to stay at camp. You will need to sign your child in each day. Please bring your own pen.

MASKS & HYGIENE

All children and staff are required to bring and wear their own mask. Frequent hand washing will be mandatory.

LUNCH & SNACKS

We DO NOT provide lunch. Your child must come to camp with a sack lunch of their own. We will provide am/pm pre-package snack.

WHAT TO BRING

Drinking fountains will not be accessible. Each child should bring their own **water bottle**. If you plan for your child to do homework and/or attend a zoom meeting with their teacher, please send all necessary items such as school papers, iPad/chrome book and all necessary passwords and user IDs. We also ask your child to bring headphones as well. No toys, blankets, stuffed animals or any other belongings from home allowed.

SOCIAL DISTANCE

There will be a limited number of spots available. Children will be grouped together in cohorts and must stay with their group and assigned staff member. Children will be 6 feet apart. Siblings may sit together.
